Club Premiership

As the past two weeks have been cancelled due to wet conditions, tonight will be the first evening of our competition period. To be eligible for a trophy on presentation day, athletes need to compete in a minimum of 60% of available events on offer during the competition period. The aim is to encourage participation and personal improvement. Full criteria for centre awards is laid out in our Year Book which all families should have received at sign on. A copy of the Year Book can be downloaded from the website and one is also chained to the notice-board in the shed.

Helpers required - Please be aware that we cannot run competition evenings without 60 to 80 parent helpers. Only helpers are allowed inside the track, so if you want to be close to your children and the action you need to sign on as a helper.

All jobs are fairly easy – measuring throws and jumps, raking sand pits, returning throwing implements to the sand pit, crowd control!! Some jobs require a little skill such as time-keeping – but nothing that can't be picked up fairly quickly. Most things are fun!!! And your assistance helps build a strong club and keep things flowing. When everything runs smoothly we finish earlier. Please consider getting a little more involved!!!

Be safe – Stay together and take care around throwing areas. Please also stop and look before crossing the track.

Each age group competes in two track relays (4 athletes per team) and three field events (unlimited athletes). There will be teams for every athlete that wishes to compete.

Please note that in the first instance athletes and parents are welcome to put forward their own teams. However, to be fair to all children, recorded performances will be used as the final determination.
